On November 25, 2014 I, C.I. Joseph J. Roberts and Chief of Police Patrick Teton was asked to go to the Bill Bacon office at the Shoshone Bannock Tribal Business Center. When we arrived the Fort Hall Business Council had wanted to draft a resolution hold persons that should or would have knowledge of Darrel Auck's body accountable for their actions. The resolution pertained to Jonathan Ish Sr., Bonnie Ish, Demeteres Ish, Aarika Edmo Ish, Frank Ish, Jonnine Sittre, and Cecyle Perez who are Shoshone Bannock Tribal Members. The resolution would if passed dis-enroll them all as tribal members where they would not get their gaming per-cap check on December 8, 2014. It would also not allow any children of theirs the ability to be enrolled with the Shoshone Bannock Tribes, or any other benefits that are entitled to a Tribal Member. This resolution was read to Demeteres Ish, Bonnie Ish and Jonnine Sittre. I was unable to contact the other parties at this time.
