

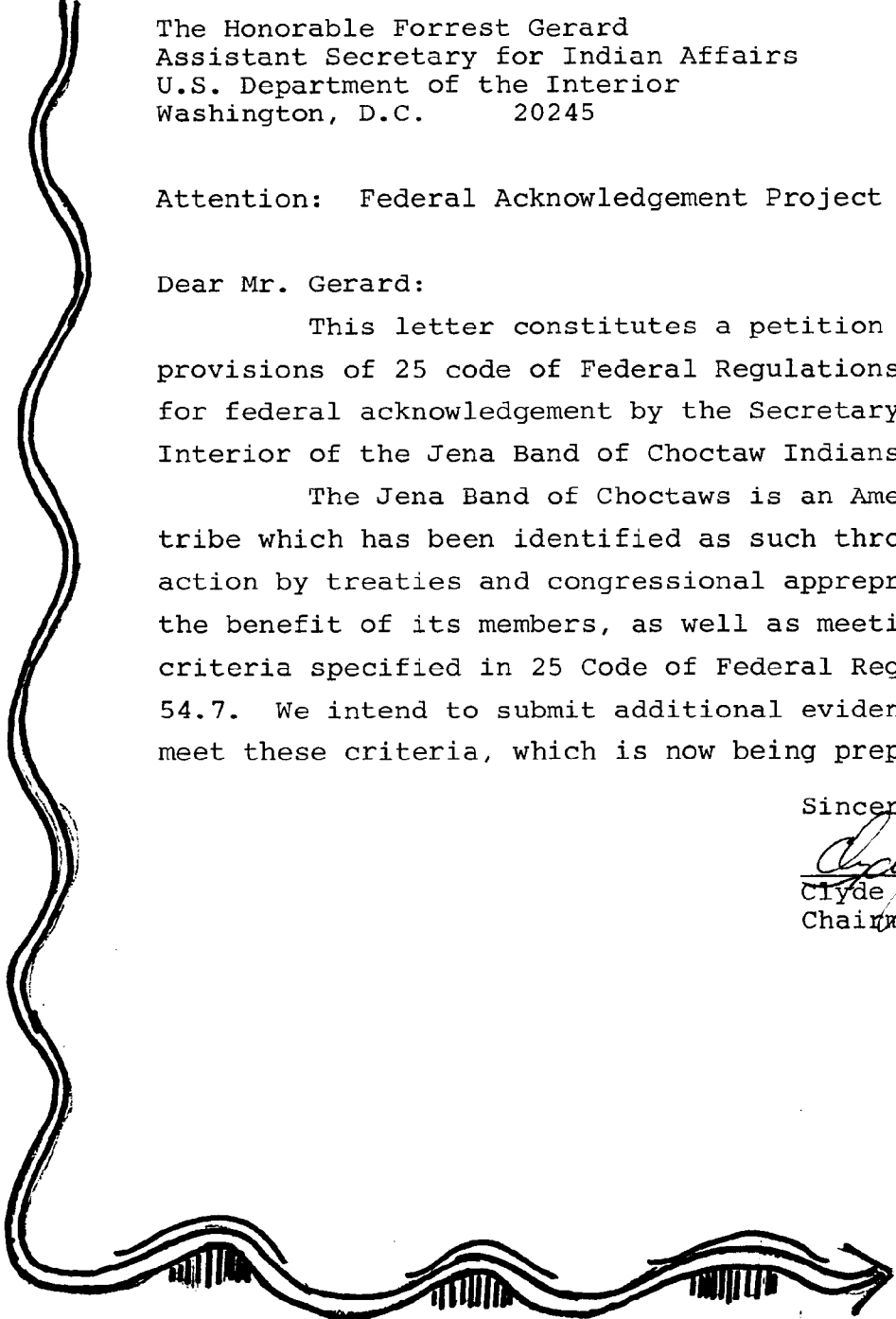
Dear Mr. Gerard:

The Jena Band of Choctaws is an American Indian tribe which has been identified as such through federal action by treaties and congressional appropriations for the benefit of its members, as well as meeting the other criteria specified in 25 Code of Federal Regulations, 54.7. We intend to submit additional evidence that we meet these criteria, which is now being prepared.
