A BILL

To clarify the boundaries of the Wind River Indian Reservation, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Wind River Reserva-
5 tion Boundary Clarification Act”.

6 **SEC. 2. RESERVATION BOUNDARY CLARIFICATION.**

7 (a) IN GENERAL.—Subject to subsection (b), not-
8 withstanding any other provision of law, the boundaries
9 of the Wind River Indian Reservation in the State of Wyo-
10 ming shall be the diminished boundaries set forth in Arti-

1 cle I of the Act of March 3, 1905 (33 Stat. 1016, chapter
2 1452).

3 (b) EXCEPTION.—Any land added to the Wind River
4 Indian Reservation pursuant to an Act of Congress after
5 the date of enactment of the Act of March 3, 1905 (33
6 Stat. 1016, chapter 1452), shall be considered to be a part
7 of the Wind River Indian Reservation.

8 **SEC. 3. TREATMENT OF THE NORTHERN ARAPAHO TRIBE**
9 **AND THE EASTERN SHOSHONE TRIBE UNDER**
10 **THE CLEAN AIR ACT.**

11 (a) IN GENERAL.—Except as provided in subsection
12 (b), nothing in this Act impacts the approval of the appli-
13 cation approved by the Administrator of the Environ-
14 mental Protection Agency and submitted by the Northern
15 Arapaho Tribe and the Eastern Shoshone Tribe for treat-
16 ment in a manner similar to a State, in accordance with
17 section 301(d)(1) of the Clean Air Act (42 U.S.C.
18 7601(d)(1)), and dated December 6, 2013.

19 (b) LIMITATION.—For purposes of the approval re-
20 ferred to in subsection (a), the boundary of the Wind
21 River Indian Reservation shall be as described in section
22 2.
