

## Biography of Rachael S. Taylor Principal Deputy Assistant Secretary Policy, Management and Budget

Rachael Taylor recently served on the U.S. Senate Committee on Appropriations for nearly 16 years. In her role as Democratic clerk of the Subcommittee on the Interior, Environment, and Related Agencies, she negotiated a \$38 billion annual appropriations bill and oversaw the budgets of Federal environmental, Tribal, and cultural agencies.

Rachael has also served in several other Legislative and Executive branch roles during her career, including in the Office of Vice President Al Gore.
