Coronavirus Capital Projects Fund – Tribal Governments

The Capital Projects Fund provides funds for eligible Tribal governments to help ensure access to the high-quality modern infrastructure, including internet, needed to access critical services.

Funding Objectives

- Directly **support recovery from the COVID-19 public health emergency** by strengthening and improving infrastructure necessary for participation in work, education, and health monitoring that will last beyond the pandemic
- Enable investments in capital assets designed to address inequities in access to critical services
- Contribute to the Administration's goal to provide every American with the modern infrastructure necessary to access critical services, including a highquality and affordable broadband internet connection

Eligible Jurisdictions & Allocations

- \$100 million in total was allocated for Tribal governments & the State of Hawaii (for Native Hawaiian Programs)
- Each Tribal government has been allocated **\$167,504**



Broadband Infrastructure Projects

Make necessary investments to provide new or expanded broadband access. Eligible projects:

- Focus on locations without access to reliable wireline speeds of 100 Mbps download / 20 Mbps upload
- Deliver reliable service with minimum 100 Mbps download / 100 Mbps upload speeds unless impracticable



Digital Connectivity Technology Projects

Purchase or install devices, such as tablets, desktop computers, laptops, and wi-fi devices to facilitate broadband adoption and use.



Eligible Uses of Capital Projects Fund Grant Funding

Multi-Purpose Community Facility Projects

Construct or improve buildings designed **to directly** enable work, education, <u>and</u> health monitoring.

- Eligible projects could include a community school or health center that provides access to the internet, devices, digital literacy training, job counseling, or other services or activities
- Multi-purpose community facilities may provide other services in addition to the required work, education, and health monitoring



Case-by-Case Review

Projects that invest in capital assets that directly enable work, education, <u>and</u> health monitoring in a community with a critical need.
