Myron is from the Pueblo of Santa Ana, born and raised there. He served the Pueblo of Santa Ana in the positions of Governor in 2003, 2013, 2016, 2024 and most recently in 2025. He has also served 3 terms as Lt. Governor. In the position of Tribal Leadership, Myron has also been elected by his peers (Governors) to chair the Ten Southern Pueblos Governors Council, which he headed in 2003, 2013 and now in 2025. In addition, in 2013, he was asked to co-chair the All Indian Pueblos Council to revamp, re-vitalize and return the former organization to its “Cultural and Leadership model”. In the past, Myron has been involved in working with Santa Ana’s economic development engine to enhance the revenue streams for the pueblo. He has been Chairs three of the business arms, Santa Ana Hospitality Corporation, Southern Sandoval Investments and Tamaya Enterprises, Inc. In the past he has worked at the Nevada Test Site, as a technician working on nuclear weapons tests and finally, today he works for the New Mexico Office of the State Engineer and Interstate Stream Commission as the agency’s Tribal Liaison.
