

Jay Spaan is a citizen of the Cherokee Nation and serves as the Executive Director of the Self-Governance Communication & Education Tribal Consortium (SGCETC). SGCETC supports the implementation and advancement of Tribal Self-Governance through education, training, sharing of information, and strategic partnerships. He is also the Executive Producer of *For Our People: Stories of Tribal Self-Governance and Sovereignty*, SGCETC's original docuseries that highlights the success and innovation of Tribal Nations. Jay also serves as adjunct faculty at Arizona State University's Sandra Day O'Connor College of Law, where he teaches courses on Tribal Self-Governance. Prior to joining SGCETC, he worked for over a decade at the U.S. Government Accountability Office, conducting evaluations of federal programs that serve Tribal Nations. He holds advanced degrees in Indian Law from the University of Tulsa and Public Affairs.
