Tehassi'tasi Hill is serving his third term as Chairman for Oneida Nation. Prior to being elected Chairman, he served two terms as a Councilmember for the Oneida Business Committee – the nine member elected government officials for the Oneida Nation.

Through his service as an elected leader, Chairman Hill continues to demonstrate a commitment to the preservation of the environment and the Oneida language, as well as the culture and traditions of Oneida Nation. He actively works to support the vision of sustainability and to exercise and protect the Nation's sovereignty. These guiding principles continue to map out his daily work for the nation, extending beyond the Oneida reservation. Chairman Hill over his tenure has embraced a transformational leadership style, which has earned him seats on different boards on both the State and Federal Level.
