





Comparing Pandemics: 1918 Influenza and COVID-19

Variable	1918 influenza	COVID-19
Available Public Health Tools	Early bacterial vaccines (for co-infections)	SARS-CoV-2 vaccines; several licensed bacterial vaccines
	Closures, isolation, social distancing, masks, simple forms of ventilation (open windows)	Closures, isolation, social distancing, masks, sophisticated ventilation (HEPA filters, air-flow control)
	Print media	Print, broadcast, internet, social media
Treatment	Supportive care	Supportive care, ICUs/advanced critical care, mechanical ventilation, ECMO
	No antimicrobial drugs	Antivirals and other antimicrobial drugs, monoclonal antibodies, immune modulators
	Quack and unproven remedies	Quack and unproven remedies
