Pending before this Court are Plaintiff's Motions in Limine, which came before this Court on March 17, 2023 and argued on the record on March 23, 2023.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Plaintiff's Motions are **GRANTED**.

Plaintiff's motion seeking to admit testimony, evidence, and argument regarding sexually harassing comments and conduct of Michael Dahl and reports of sexual misconduct of Michael Dahl is granted.
